



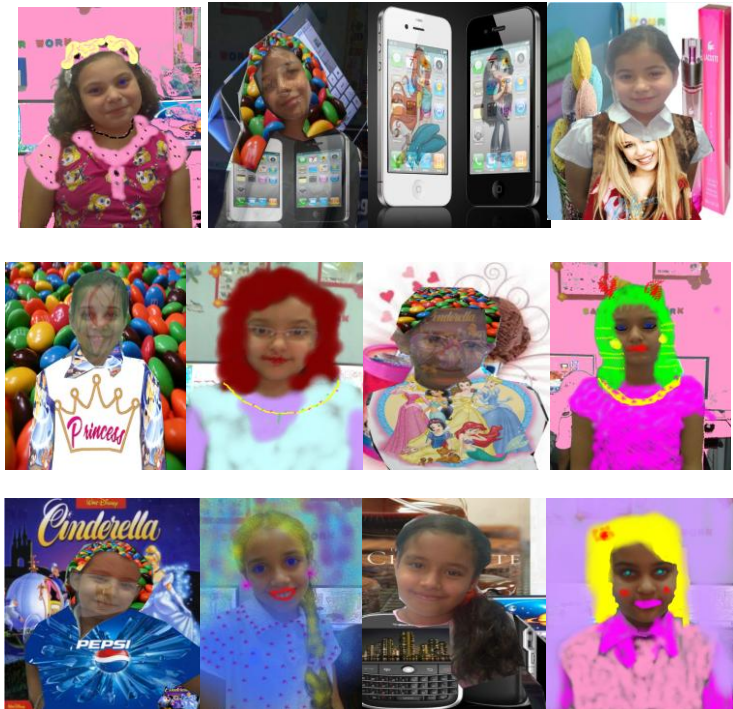
### Overview:

### Covered Objectives:

- ☞ blur an area of an image using the Blur tool
- ☞ click and drag to select a portion of an image
- ☞ copy an area of an image using the Clone Stamp tool
- ☞ copy an image
- ☞ create a text stencil and fill with a color or pattern
- ☞ crop an image
- ☞ fill an area with color using the Fill tool
- ☞ format text effects including applying a drop shadow, stroke, and pattern
- ☞ increase or decrease the magnification using the Zoom tool
- ☞ paint with color using the Paintbrush tool
- ☞ preview an image
- ☞ remove a previous action using the Undo tool
- ☞ reposition objects on the canvas using the Selection tool
- ☞ select a color from the palette
- ☞ select tool options
- ☞ set canvas size
- ☞ smudge an area of an image using the Smudge tool
- ☞ spray color using the Spray tool
- ☞ use paste inside to place an image inside a selection.
