



Overview:

In this project, students created a digital scrapbook. To start, students learned how to use a camera to take high-quality photographs. Once a library of images was established, the program Photoshop was used to transform the pictures into scrapbook pages. Ranging from whimsical to wacky, each page is a creative expression of the artist.

Covered Objectives:

- ✔ Open a picture in Photoshop
- ✔ Paint using the Brush Tool
- ✔ Adjust the intensity of the color using the Hue Saturation command.
- ✔ Correct red eye using the Red Eye Tool
- ✔ Remove imperfections using the Spot Healing Tool or Healing Brush Tool
- ✔ Enhance the color of a picture by adjusting the levels
- ✔ Create page 3,4,5 & 6 in the scrap book.
- ✔ Apply layer styles to add a shadow, glow, bevel, overlay, or stroke to objects
- ✔ Renew an old photo.
- ✔ Selection tools.
- ✔ Stamp tool.
- ✔ Using Image Menu.
- ✔ Save many photos in a letter page
- ✔ Change the fill, gradient, or pattern of a background.
- ✔ Correct lighting problems in a picture using Shadow/Highlight.
- ✔ Rename a layer
- ✔ Add and rearrange layers
- ✔ Selection tools
- ✔ Remove backgrounds
- ✔ Photos Merge
