



Overview:

In this project, students created a digital scrapbook. To start, students learned how to use a camera to take high-quality photographs. Once a library of images was established, the program Photoshop was used to transform the pictures into scrapbook pages. Ranging from whimsical to wacky, each page is a creative expression of the artist.

Covered Objectives:

- introduction to Photoshop
- parts of Photoshop window
- open a picture in Photoshop
- duplicate a picture
- add text and then format the orientation, font, size, alignment, and color
- adjust the position of a layer to change the stacking order
- paint using the Brush Tool
- apply a filter effect to transform the appearance
- open Photoshop and create a letter sized document with CMYK color
- study the layers
- place a picture
- save a picture in a different formats
- set the properties including the size and color mode of a document
- resize, rotate, and move picture and text on a layer
- correct red eye using the Red Eye Tool
- remove imperfections using the Spot Healing Tool or Healing Brush Tool
- apply layer styles to add a shadow, glow, bevel, overlay, or stroke to objects
- convert color to a gradient using Gradient Map
- magnify an area
- undo an action
- bend text on a path
